


Thank you very much to our teachers. These students need to learn the importance of elections and their rights as well as responsibilities at an early age.

This celebration enriches our understanding of the Spanish culture. It brought our community together. The students enjoyed dances and learning about the Spanish culture.













We would like to thank our parents who volunteered and helped to organize the book fair. Reading assists for the state tests and for the students to be successful in school and in the future.




The Kindness Club meets on Tuesdays, from 2:45-3:45 pm, in Ms. Steiner's class room 133.

On Monday, October 24th, Kindergarten through 2nd grade went on a field trip to Butterfly World. Butterfly World is located in Tradewinds Park in Coconut Creek, Florida, United States. It opened in 1988, and is the largest butterfly park in the world, and the first park of its kind in the Western Hemisphere. The facility houses around 20,000 live butterflies.

The Paradise Adventure Aviary includes fountains with ponds, and butterflies. The Hanging Garden & Butterfly Emerging Area has display cases with hanging pupa and emerging butterflies. The Tropical Rain Forest Aviary includes a waterfall, tropical plants, free flying birds, and butterflies.

Our BMSS students were able to view the laboratory where the butterflies are raised and can see the different stages including eggs, caterpillars, and pupas.



Summer School at BMSS

In the summer Broward Math and Science School provides 3-4 weeks of instruction to our students who are in danger of being retained or need extra support in core academic subjects. It is a four days week that has demonstrated raising success among students. Summer school is essentially a continuation of the regular school year. Therefore, just like in school, students are actively engaged in activities and tasks that force them to practice and build on previously learned skills or skills they ought to learn. Researchers show that "exposure to positive experiences, settings, and people, as well as opportunities to gain and refine academic skills, supports children in the acquisition and growth of their proficiency." BMSS summer school programs are hands-on and activity-based, especially in small group classes. These activities work to bring students together to strengthen their understanding in a safe and engaging environment. Our teachers place a lot of work into the classroom to maintain their motivation. It involves a lot of independent work to help students reach grade-level mastery and skills.

Dental Sealant

n September 7th, our Dental Program took place. Three wonderful licensed dental hygienists from the Florida Department of Health in Broward County came to our school to provide this free service for the students who signed up to participate. These students received a dental exam, education on how to properly brush his/her teeth, dental cleaning (when appropriate), dental sealants (if needed), fluoride treatment, toothbrush, toothpaste, flossers & book about tooth care, and referrals for follow-up care (if needed)



Hello Wonderful Families,

My name is Ms. Lopez. I am the Administrative Assistant at Broward Math and Science School.

Here are some important reminders:

Attendance is essential to your child's learning success. Please know it is important for them to be in the classroom by 7:55 A.M. Dismissal is at 2:30 P.M. No students shall be released within the final 30 minutes of the school day unless the principal/designee determines it is an emergency. Excessive tardiness and early sign-outs may harm your child's educational progress in the school year as they are missing out on important information that helps them with their schoolwork. Consecutive tardiness does turn into an unexcused absence.

Dress Code: School uniforms are mandatory. Students are required to wear collared polo shirts with the school logo and PE shirts and, they can only be purchased at the school. Bottoms are khaki or navy blue. Closed toe shoes, no crocs allowed. Students out of dress code will be sent to the front office and there will be consequences such as detention, Internal Suspension, no specials, being unable to participate at school events, clubs, extracurricular activities, etc.

School Hours: 7:55AM-2:30PM. Classes start promptly at 8 AM and students are dismissed at 2:30 PM. Our school opens at 7:30 am. There is no supervision prior to 7:30 AM. Students who are picked up late will be sent to aftercare at 3:00 PM. There is a \$10 daily charge for aftercare.

Aftercare: After school care is provided Monday-Friday from 2:45 PM till 6:00PM. If you are interested in after school care, you can stop by the office and ask for an aftercare application. Each session costs \$150 for 1 student and \$270 for 2 students per month. Daily rates are available at \$10 for 1 student and \$18 for 2 students.

Car tags: Please make sure you have your car tag visible with the student's assigned number. If you need an additional one, please stop by at the main office.
